WATER SECTOR REFORMS IN THE REGION -**CHALLENGES AND TRENDS**

Provision of sufficient clean water seemingly is a simple goal, yet essentially achievable only by joint engagement of society, science and technology. Besides drinking water, waste water collection, conveyance and treatment are in focus of professional attention.

The evident lack of public sewerage systems and urban and industrial wastewater treatment requires urgent solutions. These systems are prerequisites for safeguarding public health and environment and economic development incentives. Therefore, solutions which sustainably link water supplying with waste water disposal and treatment should constantly be searched for.

Belexpocentar (venue of the Exhibition on Water 2016) and the Holiday Inn hotel venue of the Water Forum 2016) are physically connected by a warm passageway.

Flood and erosion protection, agricultural irrigation and drainage, navigation, and water for use in industry and energy production, are areas which, in South East Europe, in terms of investments, have been neglected for a long period. Solutions for every water management branch require investments whose impacts will be felt over a longer term, provided that all other economic activities are organisationally and technically modernised.

Expert estimations are that in the next 20 years in Serbian water management development it should be invested between 8 and 10 billion euros, or between 400 and 500 million euros annually which would enable satisfactory sector development.

Alongside investments, reorganisation and modernisation of water management systems, it is necessary to involve science, experts, manufacturers of equipment and materials, so that through improvement and innovation of products and technologies and their placement on the market, they could contribute to more successful problem solving.

Water Forum as the most important international conference in Serbia, dedicated to actual trends, challenges, as well as economic, legal and technical issues in area of drinking water supply and wastewater disposal and treatment, will contribute to better understanding and solving current questions:

- How to reconcile challenges and approaches to transformation of water utility companies from transition policy stand point, taking into consideration preservation of capital, environmental, social and economic aspects, as well as a present trend of recommunalisation in EU countries?
- Which approaches are optimal in financing, construction and management of wastewater treatment plants, but in water supply and sewerage systems as well? What are the experiences in countries in the region?
- Which approaches to network and plants maintenance are looking ahead to future?
- How to achieve optimal energy efficiency?
- Which management opportunities does application of Asset Management offer to companies?
- Which benefits could be expected from the recommunalisation?

On these and other issues, local and foreign experts will express their views and discuss about possible solutions with other participants from the water sector, but also from industry, relevant institutions, and government officials and utility company managers particularly.

Water sector reform is important for industry and economy development. This year again, particular attention will be paid to provision of drinking water together with disposal and treatment of wastewater, through series of professional events which will take place throughout the whole manifestation jointly organised by Association for water technology and sanitary engineering - UTVSI and Belexpo plus, with the support of Chamber for Industry and Commerce of Serbia and Association of waterworks and sewerage of Serbia.
